This role will report into the Impact Data Lead and will be part of the Quality Assurance and Management Information System (QAMIS) function in the organization.

- Build efficient and well documented methods for easy, repeatable extraction & cleaning of primary and secondary data sources.
- Interpret data, analyzing results and trends, using advance data techniques where appropriate
- Generate high quality formal analytical reports on key program delivery outcomes such as Enrolment, Retention and Learning, as per defined calendar
- Conduct periodic data quality assessments through pattern and outlier analysis
- Develop dashboards to monitor performance & quality of program delivery
- Process ad hoc data requests and the deliverable should be timely, accurate and supported by definitions and insights where appropriate
- Assess the data demand for the organization and generate logs for dashboard and report usability
- Carry out any other additional responsibilities as required
