

Scope of Work – Research Intern

Interns will be responsible for:

1. District-wise Philanthropic Mapping

- Conducting research to identify HNIs, industrialists, and business owners originally from or associated with Educate Girls' 80+ operational districts across Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, and Bihar.
- Compiling comprehensive profiles including background, net worth, key business interests, known philanthropic activities, foundation details (if applicable), and current social and philanthropic affiliations.
- Identifying companies owned/managed by the philanthropists headquartered in, operating from, or having significant presence in the identified districts.
- Researching their CSR interests, flagship programs, previous non-profit partnerships, and priority focus areas in alignment with Schedule VII of the Companies Act.

2. Data Management

- Capturing all findings in structured formats using Google Sheets/Excel, with clearly categorized columns for each data point.
- Ensuring consistency, accuracy, and source-based verification of data.

3. Weekly Progress Reviews

- Participating in weekly research review meetings to track progress, resolve challenges, and fine-tune research strategies.
- Presenting key findings and insights at the end of the internship.

Required Skills and Qualifications

- 1. Strong research and analytical skills with the ability to navigate public and online databases.
- 2. Proficiency in MS Office and Google Workspace (especially Excel/Google Sheets, PowerPoint).
- 3. Attention to detail and data accuracy.
- 4. Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- 5. Background in social sciences, business, public policy, or development studies is preferred but not mandatory.
